They are better than silver and gold

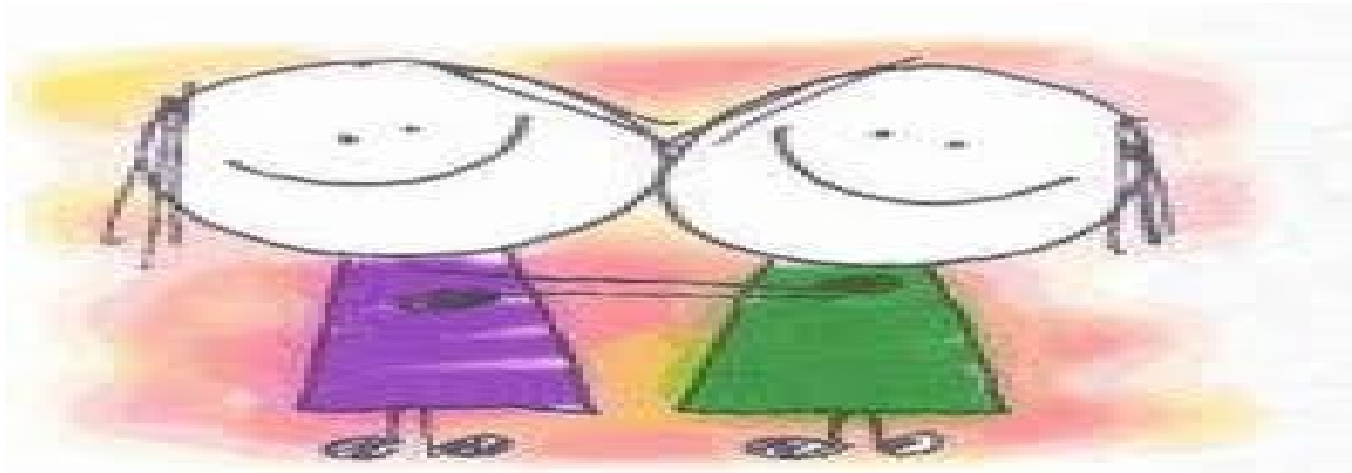


Two children thinking “what other treasures could these be” illustration

These are people we call our Friends



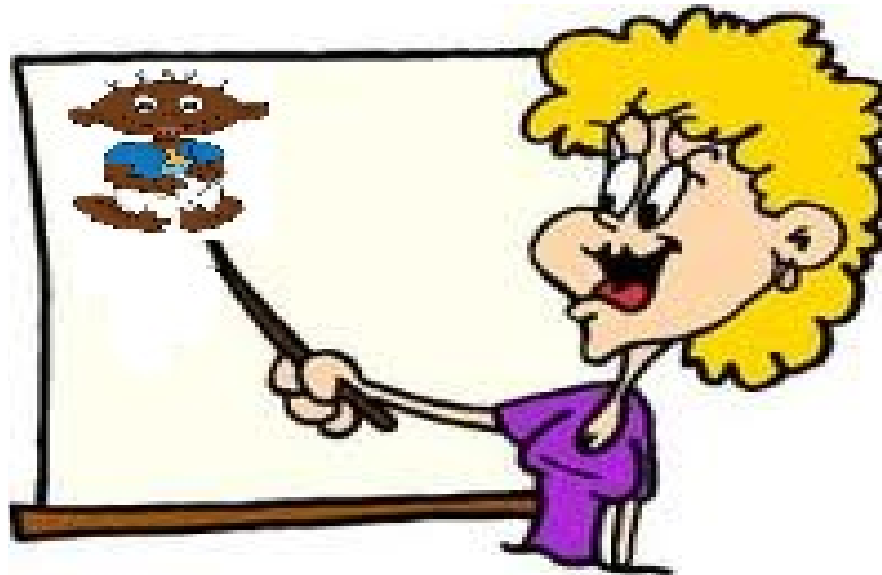
These are mothers, these are fathers
